THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TRI-SENATES TOURNAMENT RULES

- The rules and information listed below should be read carefully before entry is submitted Entry forms notfilled in properly and completely will be returned.
- Entries for this tournament are open to members that belong to USBC. The tournament will be operated under strict compliance with USBC rules.
- 3. No entries will be accepted after the closing date of the tournament.
- Personal checks will not be accepted. Fees may be paid by bank checks, money orders, certified checks or zelled to Tri Senates @ victoriadarling4978@gmail.com
- HANDICAP for this Tournament will be 100% of 630.
 Handicap is based on Team Average. Individual handicap for optional events 100% of 210.
- 6. Bowlers must use the higher of: (a) 2022-2023 book average of 21 games or more; (b) 2021-2022 book average of 21 games or more; (c) only if no 2 year book average bowler can use summer average of 21 games or more as of 8-31-2023 (a,b & c includes ChallengeAverages). If no book average for the last two seasons, or current summer average bowler must use 210. USBC rules 319a-2-3 and 319e are waived for this tournament. No Sport Averages used.
- Women entering at 139 or less average or Men entering with a 159 or less average will be handicapped at 140 for women and 160 for men. This applies for handicap purposes only! This also applies for all Optional Events.
- 8. Current PBA/PWBA, regardless of classification, will not be permitted to bowl in Tri-Senate Tournaments.
- This is a multiple team participation tournament. Must change1 bowler to compete in more than one team event. Team composition is any two-one combination.
 You may enter Singles event twice but cash only once with the highest score.
- 10. A bowler whose high league average is ten pins or more higher than book average shall be subject to average adjustment (re-rate) and in such a case, he or she shall be notified before the start of a tournament event/squad in accordance with USBC rule 319c.
- 11. NO REFUNDS. Fees after being received will not be refunded except in dire emergency, such as an employee's strike, employee's lockout, fire, acts of God, or anything else management has no control over. After the entry close date fees will not be returned. for any reason.

- 12. One hundred percent (100%) of the prize fund returned. One prize for every six entries. Championship is determined by the greatest total of handicap pinfall.
- 13. Unofficial tournament results will be distributed within 1 0 days of completion of the tournament.Brackets side pots and sweepers (optional events) will be paid the same day of the tournament, immediately after competition. Once paid all results are final.
- 14. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in any tournament within the previous 12 months must report actual score, position and amount won for possible re-rating. Any entrant having been re-rated or subject to re-rate by another tournament must report their re-rated average to the tournament director prior to bowling, failure to do so will result in disqualification. USBC Rule 319E will apply
- 15. Bowlers must wear suitable attire which is subject to the Tournament Director and/or staff's discretion. Theywill make judgment calls relative to dress codequestions or concerns, while any questionable items, special circumstances or medical exemptions will be addressed by the Tournament Manager. The use of any music/sound playing devices such as radios, CD players, boombox, etc. must be used with earphones/headphones. Female participants can wear skirts, culottes or skorts. Examples of prohibited attire include, but are not limited to tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops.
- Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament.
- 17. Substitutes will be allowed. Once a substitute starts tobowl, he/she must complete all three games of the squad that they are a substitute. <u>All substitutions/and or changes must be made at the Official Change desk before the start of each squad. All changes must be submitted on a change form.</u>
 - 18. Prize Fund: checks must be cashed within 45 days of the date on the check or the checks becomes null and void and will not be replaced.
