THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TRISENATES TOURNAMENT RULES

The rules and information listed below should be read carefully before entry is submitted. It is the bowler's responsibility to read the rules.

1. Entries for this tournament are open to members that belong to USBC. **NO NICKNAMES** entry must show name as appears in USBC on bowl.com to avoid incorrect averages. The tournament will be operated under strict compliance with USBC rules.
2. NO ONSITE entries accepted. **NO LINEUP CHANGES MADE DAY OF BOWLING.**
3. Personal checks will not be accepted. Fees may be paid by cash, bank checks, money orders, certified checks or Zelle to: **Trisenates@gmail.com**
4. **HANDICAP** for this Tournament will be **100% of 1050 based on Team Average. Singles/Pots/Optional Events 100% of 210.**
5. Bowlers must use the highest book average of 21 games Or more **(A) 2024-2025, (B) 2023-2024 (C) Summer 2025** average of 21 games or more can be used only if no 2 year book A B & C includes Challenge averages. **If no book average for any of the above bowler will use 210.** USBC rules 319a-3 and 319a-e apply. 319a-2 is waived for this tournament. **NO SPORT AVERAGES USED.**
6. **Entering average for Women 140 and for Men 160.**
7. Current PBA/PWBA, regardless of classification, will not be permitted to bowl in Tri-Senate Tournaments.
8. This is a multiple team participation tournament. **To compete together more than once must change 2 bowlers** Team composition can be any three-two combination. Singles is multiple participation cash only once with highest singles score from team event.
9. **NO REFUNDS.** Fees after being received will not be refunded except in dire emergency, such as an employee's strike, employee's lockout, fire, acts of God, or anything else management has no control over. After the entry close date fees will not be returned for any reason.
10. One hundred percent (100%) of prize fund will be returned. Prizes, Championships will be determined by the greatest total of handicap pin fall.
11. Unofficial tournament results will be distributed within 7 days after completion of the tournament. Brackets side pots and sweepers (optional events) are paid the same day immediately after competition. Once paid all results are final
12. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any event in any tournament within the previous 12 months must report actual score, position and amount won for possible re-rating. **Any entrant having been re-rated or subject to re-rate by another tournament must report their re-rated average to the tournament director prior to bowling, failure to do so will result in disqualification.** USBC Rule 319E will apply **Tournament Director has the right to adjust any bowler's average and notification is given prior to bowling**
13. Bowlers must wear suitable attire which is subject to the Tournament Director and/or staff's discretion. They will make judgment calls relative to dress code questions and/or concerns. Special circumstances or medical exemptions will be addressed by the Tournament Manager. The use of any music/sound playing devices such as radios, CD players, boombox, etc. must be used with earphones/headphones. Female participants can wear skirts, culottes or skorts. Examples of prohibited attire include, but are not limited to: hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, and sweatpants.
14. **Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament and refuse any entry/bowler to this tournament.**
15. Substitutes will be allowed. Once a substitute starts to bowl, he/she must complete all three games of the squad that they are a substitute. **All substitutions/and or changes must be made at the Official Change desk before the start of each squad or they may not be accepted. Changes made on the lanes will be done at the discretion of the Tournament Director**
